Notice of Race

1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the 2009-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the Prescriptions of Yachting Australia and by part 2 of the Yachting Australia Special Regulations, except as any of these are altered by the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions. Where there is a conflict the Sailing Instructions shall prevail.

2 ALTERATIONS TO RACING RULES

- 2.1 The Warning Signal shall not be made less than 30 minutes after "AP" is lowered ashore.
- 2.2 RRS 35 and A4.1 are amended so that all boats not finishing within the time limit shall be scored DNF.
- 2.3 Information Protestee - RRS 61.1(a) is amended by deleting "if the hull length of the protesting boat is less than 6 meters, she need not display the red flag"
- 2.4 RRS 60.2 is amended in that the Race Committee shall be represented by the Race Officer or their nominated representative.
- 2.5 RRS 66 is amended so that on the last race day of the Championship, a request to re-open a hearing shall be made within the protest time limit or within 30 minutes of being informed of the decision, whichever is the latest.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

4.1 Measurement

The Championship is open to all complying Manly Junior boats. Boats shall be available for measurement at any time during the Championship. Unless approved in writing by



the Measurer, all measured equipment shall remain the same for the duration of the Championship.

4.2 Age Limit

The age of the skipper and of the crew shall be under 16 years as at 20th February 2011. Junior Division shall be under 12 years of age at 20th February 2011.

4.3 Novice Division

The helmsperson shall be in their first season as skipper, AND shall have had no more than one season as crew. Notwithstanding, the Race Committee may accept or reject entry to this division, or may direct boats and crews to the Division.

4.4 Crew

Changes to nominated crew may be accepted at the discretion of the Race Committee and requests shall be in writing.

4.5 Insurance

All boats shall have current Public Liability insurance cover to a minimum value of AUD\$10,000,000.

4.6 Entry Fee

Shall be \$120.00 per boat (see NoR 4.7 and MJ website for full details and online registration). For entries received after the closing date (NoR 4.8) the entry fee shall be \$170.00.

4.7 Casual entries

For each round casual entries may be accepted subject to payment of \$50 per round and these boats will not count in the Championship's Point Score or Prizes.

4.8 Entry Documents

Entry Form shall be lodged online with the Manly Junior Sailing Association of NSW and shall be accompanied by the documents as detailed on the Entry Form. Entries close on 16th October 2010 at 1800hrs.

5 RACING AREA

The Organising Authority will provide a diagram of the racing area on the Regatta Notice Board on the appropriate dates.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Will be available at the registration desk and will be published on the Manly Junior Sailing Association website prior to Saturday 23rd October 2010.

7 REGATTA SITE

7.1 On each weekend the Host Club will be the Regatta Site.

7.2 A Regatta Notice Board will be erected in a prominent position at each Hosting Club.

8 COURSES

Courses shall be of triangle and windward leeward configuration. In the event that prevailing wind or sea conditions require it, a windward/leeward course may be used. Courses will be published in the Sailing Instructions.

9 PROTEST COMMITTEE

Protests will be heard as soon as practical at the Host Club after each race or at the end of the days racing. Provision will be made for a protest to be first heard by a mediator prior to a protest hearing. A mediation hearing may reach a decision on the protest or decide to send the protest to the Protest Committee.

10 SCORING

10.1 The Low Point System as per Appendix A shall apply.

10.2 Nine (9) races are scheduled of which Five (5) shall be completed to constitute the series. If 6 or less than 6 races are completed, all races shall count.

10.3 A boat may discard it's worst score after 7 races are completed

10.4 All divisions will be scored separately.



11 ADVERTISING

Competitor advertising is restricted to any event advertising the Organising Authority may require. See ISAF Regulation 20.

12 PRIZES

Prizes shall be awarded to skipper and crew. Additional prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Organising Authority.

12.1 Open Division:

- Championship trophies will be awarded for the first six places in overall scratch and handicap pointscore.
- Boats receiving first, second and third scratch recognition in the overall Championship results are not eligible for handicap recognition in the overall Championship results.
- For each race:
 - Recognition for first, second & third place on scratch & handicap.
 - Boats receiving a scratch recognition in a race are not eligible for handicap recognition in the same race.

12.2 Novice Division:

- Championship trophies will be awarded for the first six places in the overall handicap pointscore.
- Recognition for first, second and third place on handicap in each Race.

12.3 Junior Crew:

Championship trophies for the first three Junior Crews in the overall Open scratch pointscore.

12.4 All Girl Crew:

Championship trophy for the first All Girl Crew in the overall Open scratch pointscore.

12.5 Special Trophies:

These may be awarded in accordance with a deed of gift

13 DISCLAIMER

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The Organising Authorities and Regatta Sponsors will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the event.

14 MEDIA RIGHTS

The Organising Authorities shall have the right to use any names, images and sound recording taken during the event free of any charge.
