



Manly Junior NSW State Championship Round 1 Middle Harbour 16' Skiff Club

29th and 30th October 2011

Middle Harbour 16qSkiff Club invites all registered MJ sailors to participate in the first round of the 2011 State Championship to be sailed on Middle Harbour.

Where is Middle Harbour 16' Skiff Club?

The Club is located at The Spit+in Mosman, approximately 100m south of the Spit Bridge. UBD reference Map 197 C13.



FACILITIES

The club has a timber rigging deck, bistros/bars, toilets and change-rooms. There will be plenty of room to rig your boats along the foreshore on the eastern side of the Spit adjacent to the Club.

When arriving at the Club on Saturday morning please approach from the Manly side of the Spit Bridge. For those travelling from the south you will need to proceed up to Seaforth and return to The Spit from the Manly side of the Spit Bridge and pull into the slip road in front of the Club.

Parking and unloading is generally plentiful and arrangements have been made with Mosman Council to accommodate visitors for the regatta. Please visit the Association website to pre order a discounted parking sticker which reduces the parking cost by 50% for the weekend (approx \$26.00 for the weekend). Stickers can be collected from the Club on the day. The Council has approved a barricaded area on the western side of Spit Rd within the Spit West car park for free parking of trailers.

If you do not pre order a parking sticker please ensure you bring plenty of coins as the meters do not take credit cards.

The Club will provide parking marshals to help in this regard and it is requested you follow their instructions to enable everyone to unload in an organised manner.

We have also been advised that the Rowing Club opposite the Club, which also utilises the carpark, has a schools regatta on Saturday 29th so suggest you aim to arrive early.

DROP OFF AND PICKUP

Saturday 29th from 0730hrs . MH16SC Marshalls will be on hand to direct competitors and enable unloading.

Late registration will be available from 8.00am.

Between Races . All competitors are expected to return to the Club between races (unless back to back racing takes place) where there is adequate space on the deck and beach.

Overnight Storage . Competitors are welcome to leave their boats overnight at the Club but storage may be limited.

It is not recommended that boats be left on the deck or adjacent beach area overnight.

Sunday 30th . MH16SC parking marshals will be on hand as the previous day.

Canteen

The newly renovated Club has a bistro and takeaway located inside the shed on the rigging deck level.

This will be open from 8.00am Saturday morning providing Bacon and Egg rolls, Coffee, Tea and Soft Drinks.

From 10.00am, takeaway lunch will be available prior to racing at 12.00hours.

The upstairs Bistro opens from 12.00pm-3.00pm for a more formal lunch and parents are welcome to indulge if not going out on the water. It is suggested you may wish to book a table in advance.

The Bar is open from 10.30am.

Dinner in the Bistro is available from 6.00pm-9.00pm (last orders) on Saturday evening.

On Sunday, the upstairs Bistro is now open for a buffet breakfast from 8.30am-11.00am and lunch from 12.00-3.00pm.

A limited takeaway breakfast similar to Saturday will also be available.

Again the Bar is open from 10.30am.

We have a large wedding function on Sunday from 4.00pm so the Rigging Deck Bar+ will be open from 3.00pm to accommodate members and visitors

Spectator Boats: MH16C is unable to offer spectator boats. Those wishing to view the racing from the water will be required to make their own arrangements in this regard. However, an excellent view of the racing area can be afforded from the lookout at the end of Cutler Rd, Clontarf or Tanya Park at Dobroyd Head.
