## 1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the 2009-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the Prescriptions of Yachting Australia and by Part 2 of the Yachting Australia Special Regulations, except as any of these are altered by the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions. Where there is a conflict the Sailing Instructions shall prevail.

## 3 REGATTA SITE AND RACING AREA

The regatta is to be conducted from the Point Wolstoncroft Sport and Recreation Centre, Kanangra Drive, Gwandalan, NSW (<http://www.dsr.nsw.gov.au/pointwolstoncroft/>) The racing area will be the waters of Lake Macquarie adjacent to the Camp.



## **4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

### **4.1 Crew Eligibility**

Open to members of a club and who are members of Yachting Australia.

### **4.2 Boat Eligibility**

The Rookie Group is open to all Manly Junior boats. Measurement is not required to participate.

### **4.3 Entry Fee**

Entry Fee is \$50.00 per boat.

### **4.4 Entry Documents**

Entry Form shall be lodged online with the Manly Junior Sailing Association of NSW and shall be accompanied by the documents as detailed on the Entry Form.

### **4.5 Minimum Safety Requirements**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race – see DISCLAIMER below. Minimum safety requirements include: sailors need to be competent swimmers, a secure tow ring, bailer tied in (if not self draining), Personal Buoyancy to be worn at all times on the water, rudder held securely in with pin, centreboard tied in and mainsail quick release device working properly.

### **4.6 Insurance**

All boats shall have current Public Liability insurance cover to a minimum value of AUD\$10,000,000.

## **5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

Will be available at registration.

## **6 COURSES**

Courses shall be of triangle and windward leeward configuration.

## **7 DISCLAIMER**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The Organising Authorities and Regatta Sponsors will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the event.

## **10 PRIZES**

Certificates shall be awarded to skipper and crew. Additional prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Organising Authority.

## **11 MEDIA RIGHTS**

The Organising Authorities shall have the right to use any names, images and sound recording taken during the event free of any charge.
